Join filmmakers Marylou and Jerome Bongiorno for a screening and discussion of “Hearing Voices,” a movie they created featuring Italian inventor Antonio Meucci and Italian patriot Giuseppe Garibaldi who reunite as ghosts at the home they shared in 1850s, in Staten Island, NY. The two protagonists detail their legacies—the invention of the telephone and Italian unification—and debate the bigger question of: *why do we fight?*
